On September 15, 2021 at approximately 11:50 PM a deputy from the Brown County Sheriff's Office assisted by a patrolman from the Fayetteville Police Department attempted to serve a warrant on Jery Sexton, a 60 year old male, for resisting arrest.

When contact was made with Mr. Sexton he ordered his pit bull mix K9 to attack the law enforcement officers. During the warrant attempt the K9 came at the officers aggressively and was shot and injured. Mr. Sexton then came towards the officers with a board and continued to resist arrest. Mr. Sexton was taken into custody after a Taser deployment and medically checked by Fayetteville Fire and EMS.

The Brown County Dog Warden's office responded to the scene and removed the injured K9 as well as another K9 from the property. Jery Sexton is currently in the custody of the Brown County Sheriff's Office and charges are pending.
