**SUBJECT:** Vehicle pursuit

On September 16, 2018 at approximately 8:12 PM Deputies from the Brown County Sheriff's Office attempted to stop a silver Hyundai SUV for an equipment violation. When the Deputy activated his emergency lights to pull the vehicle over it then pulled into a driveway on New Harmony Salem Rd. As the Deputy exited his marked patrol vehicle the suspect vehicle fled through a yard and back onto the roadway. The suspect vehicle reached speeds around 80 miles per hour during the pursuit. When a second Deputy entered into the pursuit the male driver began shooting at the Deputies striking the lead vehicle. The suspect vehicle ended up crashing in the front yard of a residence located at 2036 Maple Grove Rd and coming to rest on its top. The driver fled the accident into a field where he was taken into custody moments later as well as a passenger who was still in the vehicle. Multiple firearms were recovered from the vehicle.

The driver of the vehicle was identified as Michael Hall, 36 year old white male, from the Mt Orab area. The passenger was identified as Daniel Allen, 37 year old male, from the Batavia Area. Hall and Allen were treated at Mt Orab Mercy Hospital and then taken to the Brown County Sheriff's Office. Charges have been filed for having weapons under disability, attempted murder, as well as other criminal and traffic violations.
