Press Release

On July 25, 2017, multiple individuals were indicted for their involvement in two different overdose death investigations in Brown County.

The investigation began on October 21, 2017, when the body of Roger Duffy, 46-year-old male, was discovered at 5107 Evans Run Rd., Georgetown, Ohio. The Montgomery County Coroner's Office determined the cause of death to be from multiple drug intoxication (fentanyl, fentanyl analogs).

On December 2, 2017, officers were again dispatched to 5107 Evans Run Rd., Georgetown, Ohio, where they discovered Darren Sheldon, 28-year-old male, deceased. The Montgomery County Coroner's Office determined the caused of death to be from multiple drug intoxication (fentanyl, heroin).

Aaron Brandenburg, 28-year-old male, was charged with 10 counts, including 2 counts of Involuntary Manslaughter, 4 counts of Corrupting Another with Drugs, 2 counts of Aggravated Trafficking in Drugs, and 2 counts of Trafficking in Heroin.

Travis Smith, 23-year-old male, was charged with 10 counts, including 2 counts of Involuntary Manslaughter, 4 counts of Corrupting Another with Drugs, 2 counts of Aggravated Trafficking in Drugs, and 2 counts of Trafficking in Heroin.

These charges are a result of the investigation by the Brown County Drug and Major Crimes Task Force into the deaths of both Roger Duffy, and Darren Sheldon.

Ricky Holland, 33-year-old male, was charged with 5 counts, including Involuntary Manslaughter, 2 counts of Corrupting Another with Drugs, Aggravated Trafficking in Drugs, and Trafficking in Heroin. Holland's charges stem from his involvement in the death of Darren Sheldon
