On Tuesday March 9, 2021 the Brown County Sheriff's Office received a request from the Ripley Police Department to assist in an on-going stalking investigation. The investigation revealed that multiple gunshots had being fired into a residence located on State Route 52 Ripley, Ohio in the early evening of March 7, 2021. One of the shots that was fired narrowly missed striking the homeowner.

The Suspect in this investigation was identified David Campbell, DOB: 3/7/1966, who resides at 189 Quail Run Road in Pendleton County, Kentucky. Three search warrants were executed in Pendleton County to obtain further evidence in the shooting investigation. Mr. Campbell was arrested in Pendleton County Kentucky and charged with improperly discharging a firearm into a habitation. Additional charges will be presented to the grand jury as a result of this investigation.

This investigation involved multiple agencies including the Ripley Police Department, Kentucky State Police, Pendleton County Sheriff's Office, Newport Police Department, and the Brown County Drug and Major Crimes Task Force.
